IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to an amendment to the
Uniform Rules concerning legislative
changes to supreme court rules of
practice and procedure.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING, that Rule 42 of the Uniform Rules
of the Legislature is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

If a bill or portion of a bill contains matter changing a
supreme court rule of practice or procedure in civil or criminal
cases in any court, the bill shall contain a section expressly
stating the intent or purpose to change such rule; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Rule 48 of the Uniform Rules of the
Legislature is amended by changing its second paragraph to read:

**No bill may become law without an affirmative vote of a
majority of the members of each house. No bill changing rules
governing practice and procedure in civil or criminal cases in
any court may become law without an affirmative vote of two-thirds
of the members elected to each house. The yeas and nays, noting
the name of each member, on final passage of a bill, shall be
entered on the journal of each house.
