SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 24

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the construction of a
bridge or causeway across Turnagain
Arm.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the continued progress of Alaska is dependent on the
transportation facilities in the state; and

WHEREAS, the construction of a bridge or causeway across
Turnagain Arm in the Kenai Peninsula would greatly improve the
transportation facilities in Southcentral Alaska; and

WHEREAS, a more direct link with the Palmer, Seward,
Anchorage, and Kenai Peninsula areas would considerably assist
in the development of railroad and highway transportation, oil
and gas pipe lines, and power transmission lines; and

WHEREAS, a more direct route would encourage tourists to
explore the scenic wonders of Southcentral Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, Second
Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring that
the Governor is respectfully urged to direct the Commissioner of
Public Works to take any action necessary to obtain financial
assistance from the federal government in the construction of a
bridge or causeway across the Turnagain Arm in the Kenai Peninsula.
