5 Relating to the air strip at

6 Ninilchik.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION

8 ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, the present air strip near Ninilchik, located on the
10 beach, is frequently unusable because high tides and storms wash it
11 and cover it with debris; and

12 WHEREAS, the cannery and the high tension wires near the air
13 strip create a constant flight hazard; and

14 WHEREAS, the homesteaders in the Ninilchik area are willing
15 to donate private land located nearer to town, adjacent to the Oil
16 Well Road, to be used as an air strip, and have already partially
17 cleared it; and

18 WHEREAS, the Division of Aviation, Department of Public Works,
19 has examined the proposed site, and has approved it as a suitable
20 site for an air strip;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, Second
22 Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring that the
23 Governor is respectfully urged to direct the Department of Public
24 Works, through the Division of Aviation, to relocate the Ninilchik
25 air strip to the bench level adjacent to the Oil Well Road and
26 away from the beach; and be it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the
28 Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska; the Honorable Richard
29 A. Downing, Commissioner of Public Works; and the Honorable Eugene
