SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 29

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to an interim study of the
taxation, bonded warehousing, and
importation of intoxicating liquor.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND
SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, there are now before the Senate three bills relating
to the taxation, bonded warehousing, and importation of liquor;
and

WHEREAS, these related bills, Senate Bills Nos. 91, 92 and
94 are of sufficient importance to merit interim study and review
before a final legislative determination is made;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, Second
Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring that
the subject matter of Senate Bills Nos. 91, 92 and 94 is referred
to the Legislative Council to be included in its program for
interim study and be made the subject of public hearings with the
cooperation of the Departments of Law and Revenue prior to the
issuance of a report of findings and recommendations to the
Legislature in 1963.
