5 Relating to the time limit on the
6 transmission of bills between houses.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, under Uniform Rule of Procedure 64, bills other than
10 bills introduced by standing committees may not be transmitted to
11 the other house after the fiftieth day; and

12 WHEREAS it now appears advisable to extend the time limit for
13 transmission of all bills between the houses;

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, Second
15 Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring, that,
16 pursuant to Rule 64 which requires the approval of a concurrent
17 resolution by two-thirds of the membership of each house to change
18 the transmission time limit, the time limit for the transmission
19 of bills between the houses is extended through the sixtieth
20 legislative day.
