

1 IN THE SENATE BY THE FEDERAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE
2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 34
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION
5 Relating to a study regarding
6 the granting of title to
7 occupants of certain state-
8 owned lands.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
10 ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

11 WHEREAS, there now reside on state-owned lands or on lands
12 to be acquired by the state through selection many families who
13 have used small tracts for homesites for several years; and

14 WHEREAS, it is the sense of the Legislature that the possi-
15 bility, feasibility, and desirability of granting fee simple title
16 to heads of families or households who have been occupying these
17 homesites for a given time should be explored and reported on;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, Second
19 Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring, that
20 the Governor is respectfully requested and urged to direct the
21 Commissioner of Natural Resources to have the Division of Lands,
22 study, hold hearings, and report on the granting of fee simple
23 title to family homesites located on state land or land to be
24 acquired by the state with the following considerations in mind:

25 1. That the head of the family or household apply for the
26 transfer of title to the homesite;

27 2. That the homesite has been occupied by the family or
28 household continuously from and including the year 1949;

29 3. That when the application has been verified, reviewed

1 and approved by the Director of the Division of Lands, fee simple
2 title will be granted to the head of the family or household with-
3 out cost to the grantee;

4 4. That the report of the Division of Lands include an
5 estimate of the amount of land which would be involved in the
6 grants and the cost to the state of processing the claims; and

7 5. That the report with suggested legislation be submitted
8 to the Third Legislature on the day it convenes in regular session
9 in January 1963.
