SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Proposing an amendment to Article V,  
Suffrage and Elections, of the Consti-  
tution of the State of Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA;

That the following amendment to Section 1, Article V, Consti-  
tution of the State of Alaska is proposed:

"Section 1. Every citizen of the United States who is  
at least nineteen years of age, who meets registration  
requirements which may be required by law, and who is  
qualified to vote under this article, may vote in any state  
or local election. He shall have been, immediately preceding  
the election, for one year a resident of Alaska or for ninety  
days a resident of Alaska having filed a declaration of intent  
to establish exclusive residence in Alaska. He shall have  
been, immediately preceding the election, for thirty days a  
resident of the election district in which he seeks to vote.  
He shall be able to read or speak the English language as  
prescribed by law, unless prevented by physical disability.  
Additional voting qualifications may be prescribed by law  
for bond issue elections of political subdivisions"; and be it  
FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of State shall prepare  
a ballot title and proposition summarizing this proposed constitu-  
tional amendment and place them on the ballot as prescribed by  
the state constitution and the election code.
