2 SPONSOR SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to Article V,
6 Suffrage and Elections, of the Consti-
7 tution of the State of Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA;

9 That the following amendment to Section 1, Article V, Consti-
10 tution of the State of Alaska is proposed:

11 "Section 1. Every citizen of the United States who is
12 at least nineteen years of age, who meets registration
13 requirements which may be required by law, and who is
14 qualified to vote under this article, may vote in any state
15 or local election. He shall have been, immediately preceding
16 the election, for one year a resident of Alaska and for
17 thirty days a resident of the election district in which
18 he seeks to vote. He shall be able to read or speak the
19 English language as prescribed by law, unless prevented by
20 physical disability. Additional voting qualifications may
21 be prescribed by law for bond issue elections of political
22 subdivisions. A citizen who meets all other requirements of
23 this Article and as prescribed by law may vote in any
24 national election for candidates for offices of president
25 and vice-president of the United States, provided he shall
26 have established residence in Alaska at least ninety days
27 immediately preceding such national election, and shall have
28 filed a declaration of intent as required by law to establish
29 Alaska as his principal or exclusive place of residence.";
