9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN SECOND  
10 LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED:

11 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Alaska has this  
12 session expressed, through Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 1, its  
13 sorrow at the death of its late esteemed member and President of  
14 the Senate, William E. Beltz; and

15 WHEREAS, it is the wish of the Legislature that the work of  
16 this outstanding Alaskan on his homestead site not be lost to the  
17 detriment of his wife and young sons; and

18 WHEREAS, the Honorable Ernest Gruening, United States Senator  
19 from Alaska, has introduced a bill in the Senate to convey the  
20 homestead site at Unalakleet to Mrs. William E. Beltz; and

21 WHEREAS, the members of the Alaska Legislature consider this  
22 proposed conveyance a fitting and proper recognition of the ser-  
23 vices of the late Senator William E. Beltz to his state and the  
24 nation;

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Alaska in  
26 Second Legislature, First Session assembled, that the Congress is  
27 respectfully urged to give favorable consideration to S. 1065 both  
28 in honor of the late Senator William E. Beltz and to protect the  
29 future of his widow and young sons; and be it
