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SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. ~~3~~ 33

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IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

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SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

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Relating to the construction of a

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temporary log boom breakwater at the

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western end of the Bar Harbor small

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boat basin at Ketchikan, Alaska.

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN SECOND

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LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED:

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WHEREAS, the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers constructed the

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Bar Harbor small boat basin at Ketchikan, Alaska, and built

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breakwaters at the eastern and southern ends of the harbor, but

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left the western end open to permit future expansion of the harbor;

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and

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WHEREAS, high seas and a considerable amount of drift debris

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enter the harbor from the west, resulting in damage to floats and

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vessels moored in the basin; and

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WHEREAS, the construction of a temporary log boom breakwater

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would be inexpensive and easily justified by the property it would

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protect from costly damages;

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BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Alaska in

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Second Legislature, Second Session assembled, that the U. S. Army

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Corps of Engineers be requested to construct, as quickly as

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possible, a temporary log boom breakwater at the western end of

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the Bar Harbor small boat basin, Ketchikan, Alaska, and be it
