5 Relating to daily air service
6 between the cities of Fairbanks
7 and Juneau.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN
9 SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED:

10 WHEREAS, the development of improved air travel between
11 Alaskan cities is essential for the economic well-being and close
12 communication among the people of Alaska; and

13 WHEREAS, air service between the cities of Fairbanks and
14 Juneau is presently on a two-flights-a-week schedule; and

15 WHEREAS, the Wien Alaska Airlines, an old, established
16 Alaskan firm has expressed its desire to institute supplemental
17 daily flight service between Fairbanks and Juneau to best serve
18 the people of these two cities; and

19 WHEREAS, the commencement of daily flight service will
20 definitely aid commerce and speed communication between these two
21 growing cities of Alaska;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Alaska in
23 Second Legislature, Second Session assembled, that the Civil
24 Aeronautics Board is urged to grant permission to Wien Alaska
25 Airlines to institute daily commercial and passenger flight ser-
26 vice between Fairbanks and Juneau; and be it
