6 ski areas and facilities in

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN  
9 SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED:

10 WHEREAS, the development of winter sports in Alaska is to  
11 the best interest of Alaskan families and Alaskan children; and

12 WHEREAS, the development of winter sports areas in Alaska  
13 is desirable and should be encouraged in order to attract winter  
14 visitors to Alaska; and

15 WHEREAS, ski areas and facilities in Alaska are in need of  
16 assistance for the full development of Alaska as a winter sports  
17 center;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Alaska  
19 in Second Legislature, Second Session assembled, that the  
20 State of Alaska supports and encourages the development of  
21 ski areas and facilities in Alaska; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State recommends to the Rural  
23 Electrification Association of the United States and its sub-  
24 divisions in Alaska that low cost electrical power be provided  
25 to ski areas in this State; and be it

26 FURTHER RESOLVED, that this State recommends to the United  
27 States that long-term financing at depressed area interest rates  
28 be provided for the development of ski areas and facilities in  
29 Alaska; and be it
