SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 3

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the establishment of a  
post office at Russian Mission,  
Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION  
ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, the village of Russian Mission, located on the lower  
banks of the Yukon River, is without a post office; and

WHEREAS, the people of Russian Mission desire a post office;  
and

WHEREAS, the post office would serve the immediate area of  
Russian Mission and the growing trading area of the lower Yukon;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First  
Session assembled that the Honorable J. Edward Day, Postmaster  
General of the United States, is respectfully urged to establish  
a post office at the village of Russian Mission, Alaska; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to  
the Postmaster General and the members of the Alaska delegation in  
Congress.
