SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 4

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the inventorying of
state-owned furniture and equip-
ment.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, it is essential to the orderly functioning of all
branches of the state government that the nature, amount and
location of all state-owned furniture and equipment be known; and

WHEREAS, a complete inventory of all furniture and equipment
owned by the State of Alaska is not now available;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First
Session assembled that the Commissioner of Administration take
appropriate action to see that an inventory reflecting the nature,
amount and location of all state-owned furniture and equipment be
accomplished during 1961 and that a report regarding its comple-
tion be submitted to the Second Legislature, Second Session, on or
by the day it convenes in 1962.
