2 SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 10

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the appointment of post-
6 masters in certain villages of Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED:

9 WHEREAS, the villages of Chifornak and Nigtmute receive
10 weekly mail service on the regular schedule to Tununak; and

11 WHEREAS, the village of Newtok receives weekly mail on the
12 regular schedule to Cheevak and Hooper Bay; and

13 WHEREAS, the village of Napakiak receives semi-weekly mail
14 service on the regular schedule to Nunapitchuk; and

15 WHEREAS, the villages of Chifornak, Nigtmute, Newtok and
16 Napakiak, while they do enjoy regular mail service, do not have
17 postmasters and therefore cannot receive registered or insured
18 mail; and

19 WHEREAS, during the calendar year 1960 these villages re-
20 ceived the large combined total of 42,588 pounds of mail, all of
21 which had to be handled without the assistance of postmasters;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First
23 Session assembled that the Honorable J. Edward Day, Postmaster
24 General of the United States is respectfully urged to appoint
25 postmasters at the villages of Nigtmute, Chifornak, Newtok and
26 Napakiak, Alaska; and be it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to
28 the Honorable J. Edward Day, Postmaster General of the United
29 States, and to the members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
