3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the construction of an
6 area high school at Tanana.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED:

9 WHEREAS, the purpose of education to aid in solving economic
10 problems of the villages of interior Alaska is failing due to
11 a complete lack of schools above the elementary level; and

12 WHEREAS, Tanana is an ideal location for an area high school
13 due to its air service facilities, its hospital, its situation
14 on the Yukon River, and the fact that no liquor is sold in the
15 village; and

16 WHEREAS, an area high school at Tanana would attract students
17 from many villages of the interior that are now denied an educa-
18 tion; and

19 WHEREAS, there is good reason to believe that the Bureau
20 of Indian Affairs will construct a dormitory to house students
21 if a high school is built;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First
23 Session assembled that the Commissioner of Education determine
24 the type and cost of construction of a high school at Tanana;
25 that he contact the Bureau of Indian Affairs with reference to
26 constructing a dormitory in connection with such proposed high
27 school and, if the dormitory construction report is favorable,
28 that the commissioner include in his 1962-1963 budget a sufficient
29 sum to cover the state's share of constructing the proposed high

1 school at Tanana, Alaska; and be it

2 FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be delivered
3 to the Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska; and to the
4 Honorable Theo J. Norby, Commissioner of Education.
