SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 19

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the late Tolbert Scott of
Nome.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, word has been received of the passing of the
Honorable Tolbert Scott of Nome, a distinguished Alaskan; and

WHEREAS, Tolbert Scott was one of the few remaining Alaskans
representing the real pioneers of yesteryear; and

WHEREAS, he came to the gold fields at Nome at the turn of
the century, married and raised a family which still resides there,
and proceeded to take an active part in community and territorial
life; and

WHEREAS, he served the old Second Division as a member of the
Territorial House for four terms and the Territorial Senate for
one term;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First
Session assembled, that the condolences of the Senate are hereby
extended to Mrs. Valerie Scott and her family on their personal
loss, which is also a loss for the people of Alaska.
