4 SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the allocation of
6 funds for Route S-680.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED:

9 WHEREAS, Highway 97, identified by the Department of Public
10 Works in its report on proposed highways as Route S-680, is
11 desired by the people of Alaska; and

12 WHEREAS, the people of Alaska last year endorsed Bond Pro-
13 posal No. 2, which authorized money for new road construction;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, the Second Legislature, First Session, has appro-
16 priated one million dollars of the total bond authorization for
17 expenditure on new road construction; and

18 WHEREAS, before construction can begin on Route S-680, money
19 will be needed for right-of-way acquisition and surveys;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First
21 Session assembled, that the Division of Highways, Department of
22 Public Works, is advised that it is the wish of the Legislature
23 that one million dollars of the highway construction bond money
24 be programmed for Route S-680 by placing one-half of the bond
25 receipts in the highway revolving fund for right-of-way and survey
26 costs and the balance be used for highway project programming with
27 the work on Route S-680 being accomplished from both ends of the
28 route simultaneously; and be it

29 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proposed route between Fairbanks

1 and Nome be immediately placed on the Federal Highway System.
