SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 33

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the maintenance of
Division of Highways offices
throughout the State.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, the state highway program requires that roads be
constructed and maintained in each of the four major senatorial
districts of the state; and

WHEREAS, the planning, engineering, designing, and right-of-
way sections of the Division of Highways, Department of Public
Works, should be located in areas nearest to the highway con-
struction projects in the interest of greater efficiency and sav-
ings in travel costs; and

WHEREAS, it is preferable that the Division of Highways staff
offices in the four major senatorial districts of the state with-
out the necessity of legislation requiring that this be done;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First
Session assembled, that the Division of Highways of the Depart-
ment of Public Works adequately staff and maintain planning,
engineering, designing, and right-of-way sections at Nome for the
Northwestern District, at Anchorage for the Southcentral District,
at Fairbanks for the Central District, to handle all highway
projects within these districts, and that a central review office
be maintained at Juneau.
