5 Relating to the construction of small
6 boat harbors at Sand Point and King
7 Cove.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
9 ASSEMBLED:

10 WHEREAS, fishing is one of the most important industries in
11 Alaska and the sea provides one of the most important means of
12 transportation in many parts of Alaska; and

13 WHEREAS, the communities of Sand Point and King Cove are
14 strategically located in an area which provides abundant com-
15 mercial fishing twelve months of the year; and

16 WHEREAS, there are permanent facilities available in these
17 communities for the processing of sea food products; and

18 WHEREAS, there are frequently as many as 80 boats seeking
19 moorage at Sant Point or King Cove; and

20 WHEREAS, the available moorage in these communities is ex-
21 posed to the violence of the sea and has proven unsafe; and

22 WHEREAS, the community of Sand Point is a Port of Entry and
23 therefore its harbor facilities are especially important;

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, Second
25 Session assembled, that the Governor of the State of Alaska
26 direct the commissioner of the Department of Public Works and
27 the director of the Division of Waters and Harbors to construct
28 small boat harbors at Sand Point and King Cove; and be it

29 FURTIER RESOLVED that funds for these projects be provided
