BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND

SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Whereas, the projected construction of the Juneau-Taku-Atlin

Highway will provide a vital connection for Southeastern Alaska

12

with the interior of Alaska, Canada and the continental United

13

States; and

WHEREAS, the completion of the highway will provide the areas

15

of Southeastern Alaska and Canada served by it with easy access to

16

markets for their mineral, fishing, timber and other resources; and

WHEREAS, a highway linking Juneau with the continental road

18

system will enhance the use of the Alaska ferry system and add

19

further to the accessibility of Juneau and Southeastern Alaska

20

to tourists;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, Second

22

Session assembled, that the Governor is respectfully urged to

23

consult with the appropriate officials of the federal Canadian

24

Government, the Premier of the Province of British Columbia, the

25

High Commissioner of the Yukon Territory, and enlist their support

26

and that of state and federal agencies for the programming and

27

construction of this vital link with the continental highway

system.
