2 SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 46
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to a commendation of the
6 Honorable Clarence L. Anderson.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND
8 SESSION ASSEMBLED:

9 WHEREAS, the Honorable Clarence L. Anderson has recently
10 retired from a long and honorable service to the Territory and
11 thereafter to the State of Alaska; and

12 WHEREAS, he was selected as the Director of the first Terri-
13 torial Department of Fisheries, remained in that position until
14 the formation of the state Department of Fish and Game, and was
15 appointed the first Commissioner of that department; and

16 WHEREAS, it is due in great measure to his diligence and
17 skill that the people of Alaska owe their present excellent
18 Department of Fish and Game; and

19 WHEREAS, his unceasing efforts in the face of great restric-
20 tions and difficulties during territorial days, his swift and
21 efficient organizing of his department to take over the great
22 burdens imposed by statehood, his long service to Alaska, and his
23 vast knowledge of fish, fishing, and conservation have justly
24 resulted in his coming to be regarded as the "father of Alaskan
25 fisheries";

26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, Second
27 Session assembled that the Senate expresses to the Honorable
28 Clarence L. Anderson upon his retirement its highest regards and
29 its unbounded gratitude for his invaluable service to the State

1 and people of Alaska; and be it

2 FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be sent
3 to the Honorable Clarence L. Anderson.
