4 SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION
5 Commending the work of the Inter-
6 national North Pacific Fisheries
7 Commission.
8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
9 ASSEMBLED:
10 WHEREAS, the recent meeting of the American Section of the
11 International North Pacific Fisheries Commission in Juneau has
12 re-emphasized to the Senate the magnitude and importance of the
13 work of the Commission; and
14 WHEREAS, the work of the Commission is particularly vital to
15 Alaska which depends so much on its fishery; and
16 WHEREAS, the Commission acting on the behalf of the govern-
17 ments of Canada, Japan and the United States has made commendable
18 progress in the field of off-shore and in-shore fisheries re-
19 search; and
20 WHEREAS, this vital service to the Nation and the State of
21 Alaska has been accomplished while operating under great diffi-
22 culties and with overly modest financial means;
23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, Second
24 Session assembled, that it most highly commends the inter-
25 governmental cooperation and accomplishment of the International
26 North Pacific Fisheries Commission in its efforts to conserve and
27 beneficially utilize the North Pacific fishery through fishery
28 and oceanographic research, pledges its full support to the Com-
29 mission and the federal government for the furtherance of its

1 work, and urges that the financial support for its activities be
2 expanded through the efforts of the President and the Congress
3 of the United States; and be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
5 the Honorable John F. Kennedy, President of the United States;
6 the Honorable Lyndon B. Johnson, Vice President of the United
7 States and President of the Senate; the Honorable John W.
8 McCormack, Speaker of the House of Representatives; the Honorable
9 Dean Rusk, Secretary of State; the Honorable Stewart L. Udall,
10 Secretary of the Interior; the Honorable Edward Allen, Chairman
11 of the International North Pacific Fisheries Commission; the
12 Honorable Milton E. Brooding, Chairman, American Section, Inter-
13 national North Pacific Fisheries Commission; and the members of
14 the Alaska Delegation in Congress.
