For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing Alaska Standard Time
7 as the official time for the conduct of the
8 business of the state and its political
9 subdivisions."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 01.10 is amended by adding a new section to

Sec. 01.10.075. STANDARD TIME. Effective midnight,

14

December 31, 1963, the official time for the conduct of the

15

business of the state and its political subdivisions is

16

Alaska Standard Time, which is 10 hours earlier than

17

Greenwich mean time and is established for Alaska by federal

18

law (15 USC 261). The standard time prescribed in this

19

section governs with respect to all laws, regulations, and

20

rules relating to the performance of any act by an officer

21

or agency of the state and its political subdivisions, to

22

the time that any right accrues or terminates, and in all

23

contracts and choses in action made or to be performed in

24

the state.
