6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing two standard time  
7 zones for the conduct of the business of  
8 the state and its political subdivisions."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 01.10 is amended by adding a new section to  
11 read:

12 Sec. 01.10.075. STANDARD TIME ZONES. Effective mid-  
13 night, December 31, 1963, the official time for the conduct  
14 of the business of the state and its political subdivisions  
15 east of the present western boundary of Alaska Standard  
16 Time shall be Pacific Standard Time which is eight hours  
17 earlier than Greenwich mean time. That portion of the  
18 state west of the present western boundary of Alaska  
19 Standard Time remains in Bering Sea Time which is 11 hours  
20 earlier than Greenwich mean time. The standard times pre-  
21 scribed in this section govern with respect to all laws,  
22 regulations, and rules relating to the performance of any  
23 act by an officer or agency of the state and its political  
24 subdivisions, to the time that any right accrues or termi-  
25 nates, and in all contracts and choses in action made or to  
26 be performed in the state.
