5 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to eligibility for any type  
6 of commercial fishing license; and providing  
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to  
10 Article 5 to read:

11 Sec. 16.05.695. INELIGIBILITY FOR COMMERCIAL FISHING  
12 LICENSES. (a) Any person resident in an Indian reservation  
13 which has been authorized by the Secretary of the United  
14 States, Department of the Interior, to use commercial  
15 fishing gear or equipment prohibited under the laws of the  
16 State of Alaska who intends to use or who uses the commercial  
17 fishing gear or equipment in the waters of the state is  
18 ineligible for any type of commercial fishing license issued  
19 under secs. 440 - 720 of this chapter.

20 (b) A person ineligible for any type of commercial  
21 fishing license under (a) of this section who fishes com-  
22 mercially in the waters of the State of Alaska is guilty of  
23 a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable as provided  
24 in sec. 720 of this chapter.

25 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
26 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
