6 For an Act entitled: "An Act changing the membership of the
7 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 04.05.010(a) is amended to read:

11 Sec. 04.05.010. CREATION OF BOARD AND OFFICE OF DIRECTOR.

12 (a) There is established an Alcoholic Beverage Control Board
13 within the Department of Revenue consisting of five [THREE]
14 members appointed for overlapping three-year terms. One
15 member shall be appointed from each of the four judicial
16 districts and the fifth member shall be the secretary of
17 state. The board is vested with the duties, powers, and
18 responsibilities involved in the control of alcoholic bever-
19 ages, including the promulgation of rules and regulations and
20 the hearing of appeals from the action of officers and em-
21 ployees charged with enforcing the alcoholic beverage control
22 laws, rules, and regulations. The governor shall appoint
23 the appointive members of the board subject to confirmation
24 by the legislature. No appointed member of the board may
25 hold any other state or federal office, either elective or
26 appointive. One member of the board shall be actively en-
27 gaged in the alcoholic beverage industry. No two members of
28 the board may be engaged in the same business, occupation or
29 profession. Three [TWO] members shall constitute a quorum

for the conduct of business. The board shall meet at least once each year [IN EACH OF THE FOUR JUDICIAL DISTRICTS] to study, reconsider, and modify existing agency rules and regulations in the light of current local problems.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
