6 For an Act entitled: "An Act permitting authorized deductions
7 from the wages of employees of the state and
8 its political subdivisions for payment to a
9 charitable fund."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 39 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

12 CHAPTER 40. CHARITABLE WAGE DEDUCTIONS

13 Sec. 39.40.010. AUTHORIZATION. An employee of the
14 state or of its political subdivisions may give written
15 authorization to permit his employer to deduct a sum of
16 money each month from his wages for payment to a charitable
17 fund of his choosing.

18 Sec. 39.40.020. ADMINISTRATION. (a) The wage deduc-
19 tions withheld under sec. 10 of this chapter shall be
20 immediately paid over to the designated charitable fund by
21 the Department of Administration or the official of the
22 political subdivision in charge of disbursing funds for the
23 payment of wages to employees.

24 (b) The Department of Administration shall adopt regu-
25 lations to carry out the purposes of secs. 10 - 30 of this
26 chapter.

27 Sec. 39.40.030. DEFINITION. In secs. 10 - 30 of this
28 chapter "charitable fund" means (1) a commonly known United
29 Fund or Community Chest organization conducting a single,
