6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to labor disputes and the
7 obtaining of employees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.05 is amended by adding new sections to
10 read:

11 ARTICLE 10. STRIKES AND LOCKOUTS

12 Sec. 23.05.425. RECRUITMENT OF STRIKEBREAKERS. No per-
13 son, firm, or corporation not directly involved in a labor
14 strike or lockout may recruit and bring into the state any
15 person for employment, or secure, or offer to secure employment
16 for any person, when the purpose of recruiting, securing or
17 offering to secure employment is to take the place in the
18 employment of employees in a business owned by a person, firm,
19 or corporation involved in a labor strike or lockout.

20 Sec. 23.05.430. IMPORTATION OF PICKETS BY UNION. No
21 labor union may bring into this state persons to act as
22 pickets of a business owned by a person, firm, or corporation
23 where a labor strike or lockout exists.

24 Sec. 23.05.440. EXCEPTIONS. Secs. 425 - 430 and 450 of
25 this chapter do not apply to activities and services offered
26 by or through the Department of Labor.

27 Sec. 23.05.450. PENALTIES. A person who violates secs.
28 425 - 430 of this chapter is punishable by imprisonment for
29 not more than two years, or by a fine of \$1,000, or by both.
