6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the employment of
7 prisoners on public works projects."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.05.110 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 11.05.110. EMPLOYMENT OF IMPRISONED PERSONS. The
11 commissioner of health and welfare shall adopt regulations to
12 govern the employment on public works of persons sentenced to
13 imprisonment in a jail, prison facility, or prison inside the
14 state.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 33.30.020 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 33.30.020. COMMISSIONER TO ESTABLISH AND ADMINIS-
17 TER PRISON FACILITIES. The commissioner shall establish
18 prison facilities and classify the prisoners in prison
19 facilities. He shall provide for the safety, subsistence,
20 proper government, and discipline of prisoners. He shall
21 establish programs for the treatment, care, rehabilitation
22 and reformation of prisoners. He may, under regulations which
23 he adopts, employ or cause to be employed upon public works
24 any prisoner who has been sentenced to imprisonment.
