BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 14.20.220 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 14.20.220. MINIMUM TEACHERS' SALARY SCALE BY

SENATE DISTRICT. (a) The school board of each school dis-  
13 trict in the state shall pay a regularly qualified teacher  
14 employed by it a salary not less than that set forth in the  
15 following scale:

5 (2) Southcentral Senate District. In the South-  
6 central Senate district, the amount of \$400 shall be added to  
7 each step of the Southeastern Senate District salary scale;

8 (3) Central and Northwest Senate Districts and that  
9 part of the Southcentral Senate District lying west of 152°  
10 West Longitude. In the Central and Northwest Senate Districts  
11 and in that part of the Southcentral Senate District lying  
12 west of 152° West Longitude, the amount of \$700 shall be  
13 added to each step of the Southeastern Senate district salary  
14 scale.

15 (b) The state Department of Education, as the operating  
16 agency of schools outside school districts, shall pay a  
17 regularly qualified teacher employed by the state a salary not  
18 less than \$500 per year above the salary set out in (a) of  
19 this section.

20 (c) Not more than four years of public school experience  
21 outside the state may be substituted for a like period of  
22 public school experience in the state when a teacher's posi-  
23 tion on the salary scale is established.

24 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1963.
