6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the minimum teachers'  
7 salaries; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.220 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 Sec. 14.20.220. MINIMUM BASE TEACHERS' SALARY AND SALARY  
12 SCALE INDEX BY SENATE DISTRICT. (a) The school board of each  
13 school district in the Southeastern Senate District shall pay  
14 a regularly qualified teacher employed by it, with a bachelor's  
15 degree and no public school experience in Alaska, a salary of  
16 not less than \$6,000 per year. All other regularly qualified  
17 teachers employed by the school board of each school district  
18 in the Southeastern Senate District shall receive annual sal-  
19 aries according to the index set out below, with the index  
20 figure of 1.00 representing the base salary of \$6,000:

9 (b) In the Southcentral Senate District, the amount of  
10 \$400 shall be added to each salary as computed under (a) of  
11 this section.

12 (c) In the Central and Northwest Senate Districts and in  
13 that part of the Southcentral Senate District lying west of  
14 152° West Longitude, the amount of \$700 shall be added to each  
15 salary as computed under (a) of this section.

16 (d) The state Department of Education, as the operating  
17 agency of schools outside school districts, shall pay a regu-  
18 larly qualified teacher employed by the state a salary not  
19 less than \$500 per year above the salary as computed under  
20 (a), (b), and (c) of this section.

21 (e) Not more than four years of public school experience  
22 outside the state may be substituted for a like period of  
23 public school experience in the state when a teachers position  
24 on the salary scale is established.

26 Sec. 14.20.240. SALARY SCALE FOR SUPERINTENDENTS,

agency for schools outside school districts shall pay regularly qualified superintendents, principals, teaching principals, head teachers and teachers-in-charge a salary which shall be not less than the allowable base salary for the Senate District in which employed, as provided in AS 14.20.220, plus a percentage of that base salary according to the following schedule:

Teacher-in-charge	4 per cent
Head Teacher	7 per cent
Teaching Principal	10 per cent
Principal	15 per cent
Superintendent	20 per cent
