6 For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating refunds of the tax  
7 on nonprofit electric and telephone member-  
8 ship cooperatives to municipalities, inde-  
9 pendent school districts, public utility  
10 districts and boroughs, and providing for  
11 an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. The sum of \$118,602 is appropriated from the  
14 general fund to the following municipalities, independent school  
15 districts, public utility districts and boroughs in the listed  
16 amounts as refunds of the portion of the tax on nonprofit electric  
17 and telephone membership cooperatives earned within such juris-  
18 dictions during 1962, according to the provisions of AS 10.25.570.
