6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to personalized motor
7 vehicle registration plates."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.10 is amended by adding a new section to
10 read:

11 Sec. 28.10.205. PERSONALIZED REGISTRATION PLATES. (a)
12 The department shall design and issue upon request personal-
13 ized letter registration plates or a combination of per-
14 sonalized letter and number registration plates for a motor
15 vehicle not designed, used, or maintained primarily for the
16 transportation of passengers or property for hire.

17 (b) The department shall charge a fee of \$10 in addi-
18 tion to the annual license tax prescribed under sec. 200(b)(2)
19 of this chapter. The fee shall be paid to the department at
20 the time of applying for the personalized plates and when
21 a set of personalized plates is replaced by the department.

22 (c) A person to whom personalized registration plates
23 have been issued may retain them so long as he continues to
24 pay the annual registration fee and he may transfer the
25 registration plates to another motor vehicle he owns or
26 purchases in the event that he disposes of the motor vehicle
27 for which the registration plates were first issued.

28 (d) The department shall further prescribe regulations
29 dealing with the issuance, transfer, and design of

Sec. 28.10.130. DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT PERMANENT PLATES. The department may select permanent registration plates consisting of a main plate and a yearly insert plate bearing the last two numbers of the year for which the license is issued. Except in the case of personalized registration plates issued under sec. 205 of this chapter, the [THE] main plate shall remain with the vehicle as long as it is required to be registered in the state, and the yearly insert plate shall remain with the vehicle for the period of registration.
