5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to personalized motor  
7 vehicle registration plates."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 28.10 is amended by adding a new section to  
10 read:

11 Sec. 28.10.205. PERSONALIZED REGISTRATION PLATES. (a)

12 The department shall design and issue upon request personal-  
13 ized letter registration plates or a combination of per-  
14 sonalized letter and number registration plates for a motor  
15 vehicle.

16 (b) The department shall charge a fee of \$20 in addi-  
17 tion to the annual license tax prescribed under sec. 200(b)  
18 (2) of this chapter. The fee shall be paid to the department  
19 at the time of applying for the personalized plates.

20 (c) A person to whom personalized registration plates  
21 have been issued may retain them so long as he continues to  
22 pay the annual registration fee and he may transfer the  
23 registration plates to another motor vehicle he owns or  
24 purchases in the event that he disposes of the motor vehicle  
25 for which the registration plates were first issued.

26 (d) Issuance of duplicate personalized registration  
27 plate. If a personalized registration plate is lost,  
28 mutilated or destroyed, the owner of a registered vehicle  
29 may obtain a duplicate from the department by filing an

1 application showing the fact of loss, mutilation or destruc-  
2 tion and paying the actual cost of the plate.

3 (e) The department shall further prescribe regulations  
4 dealing with the issuance, transfer, and design of personal-  
5 ized registration plates provided for under this section.

6 \* Sec. 2. AS 28.10.130 is amended to read:

7 Sec. 28.10.130. DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT PERMANENT PLATES.

8 The department may select permanent registration plates con-  
9 sisting of a main plate and a yearly insert plate bearing the  
10 last two numbers of the year for which the license is issued.

11 Except in the case of personalized registration plates issued

12 under sec. 205 of this chapter, the [THE] main plate shall  
13 remain with the vehicle as long as it is required to be  
14 registered in the state, and the yearly insert plate shall  
15 remain with the vehicle for the period of registration.

16 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 1966.
