6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing November 11, Veterans
7 Day, as a legal school holiday; and provid-
8 ing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.05.050(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) No teacher may be required to teach school on
12 Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day and the day
13 immediately following Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New
14 Year's Day, Memorial Day and the Fourth of July, nor shall
15 the monthly salary of a teacher be diminished because one
16 of these holidays falls on a school day. If one of these
17 holidays falls on a Saturday, the Friday immediately pre-
18 ceding is a school holiday. If one of these holidays falls
19 on a Sunday, the Monday immediately following is a school
20 holiday.

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
22 and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
