6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the type of license issued
7 to those persons under the age of 21 years;
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 28.15.080 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 28.15.080. LICENSES ISSUED TO OPERATORS (a) Upon
12 payment of the fee prescribed, the department shall issue an
13 operator's license to a qualified applicant. The license
14 shall contain a distinguishing number assigned to the licen-
15 see, the full name, date of birth, address, and a brief de-
16 scription of the licensee, and either a facsimile of the sig-
17 nature of the licensee or a space upon which the licensee
18 shall write his signature in ink immediately upon receipt of
19 the license. A license is not valid until it is signed by
20 the licensee.

21 (b) Licenses issued to persons under the age of 21 years
22 shall be laminated and marked "minor" in large contrasting
23 letters. The agent issuing the license shall determine and
24 record on the license the age of the licensee at the date of
25 issue.

26 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
27 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
