7 of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture Examin-

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 08.28.010 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 08.28.010. CREATION AND MEMBERSHIP OF BOARD OF  
12 HAIRDRESSING AND BEAUTY CULTURE EXAMINERS. There is created  
13 a Board of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture Examiners [, REFER-  
14 RED TO IN THIS CHAPTER AS THE BOARD]. The board consists of  
15 seven [FIVE] members appointed by the governor.

16 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.28.030 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

17 Sec. 08.28.030. QUALIFICATIONS OF BOARD MEMBERS. (a)  
18 To qualify for membership on the board, a member must be an  
19 adult, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the  
20 state.

21 (b) The governor shall appoint persons so that each of  
22 five members have at least five years experience as an oper-  
23 ator, manager-operator, or owner-operator, and each of two  
24 members have at least three years experience as the owner,  
25 manager, instructor, or employee of a beauty school licensed  
26 under this chapter. To remain on the board, a member must  
27 remain active in an activity that would qualify him for  
28 appointment under this subsection.

29 (c) Each member shall take the oath provided by law for
