9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 08.28.140 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 Sec. 08.28.140. OUT-OF-STATE LICENSEES. (a) A person
12 holding a current valid license from a board of cosmetology
13 in another state is entitled to a license under this chapter
14 without the examination if he

15 (1) applies, accompanying his application with
16 proof of the foreign license;

17 (2) has completed at least 1,500 hours training
18 in a hairdressing and beauty culture school;

19 (3) meets other requirements established by regu-
20 lation of the board.

21 (b) A person who meets the requirements of (a) of this
22 section except the requirement in (a)(2) of this section is
23 entitled to a license without examination if he has worked
24 as a licensed hairdresser or cosmetologist for one year.

25 (c) A person who meets the requirements of (a)(1) and
26 (3) of this section, but who does not meet the requirements
27 of (a)(2) or (b) of this section is entitled to a license
28 without examination conditioned upon his completing 1,500
29 hours of training in a hairdressing and beauty culture
