6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to hairdressing and beauty  
7 culture."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.28.030 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 08.28.030. QUALIFICATIONS OF BOARD MEMBERS. (a)  
11 To qualify for membership on the board, a member must be an  
12 adult, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the  
13 state.

14 (b) The governor shall appoint persons so that four  
15 members have at least five years experience as an operator,  
16 manager-operator, or owner-operator, and one member has at  
17 least three years experience as the owner, manager, or in-  
18 structor of a beauty school licensed under this chapter. To  
19 remain on the board, a member must remain active in an activ-  
20 ity that would qualify him for appointment under this sub-  
21 section.

22 (c) Each member shall take the oath provided by law for  
23 public officers.
