6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing the membership of the  
7 Alaska Workmen's Compensation Board; and  
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 23.30.005 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 23.30.005. ALASKA WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION BOARD.

12 (a) A board is created which is known as the Alaska  
13 Workmen's Compensation Board and is composed of the  
14 Commissioner of Labor, two representatives [A REPRESENTATIVE]  
15 of industry and two representatives [A REPRESENTATIVE] of  
16 labor, the latter four [TWO] members to be appointed by the  
17 Governor. The Commissioner is chairman of the board, and  
18 may perform all acts necessary to carry into effect the  
19 provisions of this chapter.

20 (f) There is hereby created the position of hearing  
21 officer, which shall be a classified position. It shall be  
22 the duty of the hearing officer, acting under rules adopted  
23 by the board, to hear and determine claims for compensation  
24 and to conduct such hearings and investigations and to make  
25 such orders, decisions and determinations as may be required  
26 by any general or special rule or order of the board under  
27 the provisions of this chapter. The decision of the hearing  
28 officer on such a claim shall be deemed the decision of the  
29 board from the date of the filing thereof in the office of

1 the board unless the board, on its own motion or on applica-  
2 tion duly made to it, modify or rescind such decision.

3 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its  
4 passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such  
5 approval.
