7 resses in beverage dispensaries."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.10.040(b) is repealed and re-enacted to
10 read:

11 (b) Any employee serving intoxicating liquor in an
12 establishment operating under a beverage dispensary license
13 shall be a citizen of the United States, of good moral charac-
14 ter, and over the age of 21 years. An employee of an
15 establishment violating provisions of this section is equally
16 guilty with the holder of the license and is punishable ac-
17 cordingly.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 04.15.090(a) is amended to read:

19 (a) No female person shall be employed by a liquor or
20 beverage dispensary, club, road house, restaurant, or common
21 carrier dispensary license issued under the laws of the state
22 to solicit, entice, or encourage the purchase by patrons of
23 a licensed premises of alcoholic beverages upon a rebate,
24 percentage, or share the profit basis, or any other basis;
25 nor may any female person receive a salary or other compensa-
26 tion from a person for the solicitation, enticement, or en-
27 couragement of the purchase of alcoholic beverages.

28 ...a fide entertainers, hat check girls, cocktail waitresses,
29 and female employees not directly or principally employed to

* Sec. 3. AS 04.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 04.15.095. COCKTAIL WAITRESSES. (a) No female person under 21 years of age may be employed as a cocktail waitress.

(b) No cocktail waitress may, during working hours, wear an abbreviated or revealing costume, or sit with or entertain a customer, or accept a drink bought for her by a customer.

(c) No cocktail waitress may tend bar.

* Sec. 4. AS 04.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 04.15.110. DEFINITION. In this chapter "cocktail waitress" means a female person who is employed in an establishment licensed under AS 04.10 to sell intoxicating liquors for the purpose of accepting and delivering orders of intoxicating beverages to customers of the establishment.
