6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to prohibitions with respect
7 to certain females in connection with sales
8 of beverages upon licensed premises; and
9 providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 04.15.090 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

12 Sec. 04.15.090. PROHIBITION WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN
13 FEMALES IN CONNECTION WITH THE SALE OF BEVERAGES UPON
14 LICENSED PREMISES. (a) No female person employed in any
15 capacity or for any purpose by the holder of a license for a
16 beverage dispensary establishment, club, road house, restau-
17 rant, or common carrier dispensary, or by the operator or
18 manager thereof, may solicit or encourage the purchase of any
19 beverage, alcoholic or otherwise, by patrons of the licensed
20 premises for consumption by such patrons or by such female
21 person; nor may any such female person accept any beverage,
22 alcoholic or otherwise, purchased by a patron of such an
23 establishment.

24 (b) No female person, whether an employee or patron of
25 any licensed beverage dispensary establishment, club, road
26 house, restaurant, or common carrier dispensary may remain
27 about the premises of any such establishment and solicit any
28 beverage, alcoholic or otherwise, from any patron of said
29 establishment, whether the beverage be for herself, the

1 patron or another.

2 (c) No holder of a license for a beverage dispensary
3 establishment, club, road house, restaurant, or common car-
4 rier dispensary, or an operator or manager thereof, may
5 permit any female person employed by him, in any capacity or
6 for any purpose, to solicit or encourage the purchase of any
7 beverage, alcoholic or otherwise, by patrons of the said
8 licensed premises for consumption by such patron or by such
9 female person, nor may any such holder, operator, or manager
10 permit any female employee to accept any beverage, alcoholic
11 or otherwise, purchased or offered by a patron of any such
12 licensed premises.

13 (d) No holder of a license for a beverage dispensary
14 establishment, club, road house, restaurant, or common car-
15 rier dispensary, or an operator or manager thereof, may permit
16 any female person whatever to remain about the premises of
17 any such establishment and solicit any beverage, alcoholic or
18 otherwise, from any patron of such licensed premises, whether
19 the said beverage be for herself, the patron or another.

20 (e) Any holder of a license for a beverage dispensary
21 establishment, club, road house, restaurant, or common car-
22 rier dispensary, or the operator or manager thereof, or any
23 female employee thereof, who violates this section is guilty
24 of a misdemeanor.

25 (f) Any female person, not an employee of any licensed
26 premises described in this section, in violation of subsec-
27 tion (b) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.

28 * Sec. 2. AS 04.15.100(a) is amended to read:

29 (a) A person who violates any provision of this title

1 other than sec. [SECTIONS] 80 [AND 90] of this chapter is
2 guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable
3 by imprisonment of not more than one year, or by a fine of
4 not more than \$500. Each violation is a separate offense.

5 * Sec. 3. AS 04.10.040(b) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

6 (b) A citizen of the United States, over the age of
7 21 years and of good moral character may be regularly
8 employed as a waiter or waitress in any establishment operat-
9 ing under a beverage dispensary license. The duties of
10 waitresses employed therein shall be confined to the taking
11 of orders and the serving of beverages, alcoholic or other-
12 wise, and food. Waitresses employed under this section may
13 not solicit or encourage the purchase of beverages, alcoholic
14 or otherwise, by any patron of said premises, whether the
15 beverage be for the patron or for another. No waitress may
16 accept any beverage, alcoholic or otherwise, purchased for
17 her by any patron of said establishment. The licensed
18 premises must apply for and receive a permit from the board
19 to employ female persons as waitresses.

20 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
21 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
