6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to type of school experi-
7 ence acceptable for teacher placement on the
8 salary scale and for retirement credit; and
9 providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 14.20.220 is amended by adding new subsections
12 to read:

13 (d) Not more than four years of private school experi-
14 ence outside the state may be substituted for a like period
15 of public school experience in the state, if

16 (1) the private school is an accredited school;

17 (2) the state in which the private school is located
18 has certification requirements at least as high as those of
19 Alaska;

20 (3) the teacher was certified to teach by that state

21 (e) Not more than four years in the aggregate may be
22 substituted under (c) and (d) of this section.

23 * Sec. 2. AS 14.25.220(8) is amended to read:

24 (8) "outside service" means

25 (A) service as a "teacher" in a public school
26 not under the supervision and control of the Department
27 of Education or the Territorial Board of Education, the
28 school board of an incorporated city, incorporated

(B) service as a classroom teacher in a private school if this service would meet the criteria for substituted experience under AS 14.20.220(d).
