6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to regular and overtime  
7 compensation for state employees; and pro-  
8 viding for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 39.27 is amended by adding new sections to  
11 read:

12 Sec. 39.27.020. SUPPLEMENTARY MONTHLY SALARY SCHEDULES.

13 On July 1, 1963, the monthly salary schedules set out in  
14 sec. 10 of this chapter, with the following changes, shall be  
15 the pay plan for employees of the state:

- 16 (1) increase ranges 2 - 16 by six per cent;  
17 (2) increase ranges 17 - 22 by seven per cent;  
18 (3) increase ranges 23 - 28 by 10 per cent.

19 Sec. 39.27.030. OVERTIME PAY. (a) A state employee  
20 required to work in excess of the regular hours of employment  
21 shall be paid one and one-half times the computed hourly  
22 salary rate for his position for each hour worked in excess  
23 of the regular hours of employment.

24 (b) The overtime pay authorized by this section is paid  
25 only when the work is authorized in advance and in writing by  
26 an employee's immediate supervisor.

27 (c) This section applies to all state employees except  
28 those who serve in supervisory, professional, or executive  
29 positions.
