6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to pay and position classi-
7 fications in the state personnel rules."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.25.150(1) is amended to read:

10 (1) the preparation, maintenance, and revision by
11 the director of personnel, subject to approval by the com-
12 missioner of administration and the personnel board, of a
13 position classification plan for all positions in the classi-
14 fied and partially exempt services; in the position
15 classification plan all positions shall be grouped together
16 into classes on the basis of duties and responsibilities; the
17 position classification plan shall include for each class of
18 position an appropriate title, a description of the duties
19 and responsibilities, training and experience qualifications,
20 with minimum requirements no greater than those for compar-
21 able federal government positions, and other necessary
22 position specifications;
