6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to benefits for World War II
7 veterans; preferences for Alaska veterans;
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 26.15.130(a)(1) is amended to read:

11 (1) persons who served in the armed forces of the
12 United States for 90 days or more, or whose service was for
13 less than 90 days because of injury or disability incurred in
14 line of duty, between September 16, 1940, and July 25, 1947,
15 who were separated from the armed forces with an honorable
16 discharge or honorable separation, and (A) who, at the time
17 of induction into the service, were residents of the terri-
18 tory, who had been residents for not less than one year im-
19 mediately before their induction and who returned to the
20 territory or state after discharge as residents with the
21 intention of remaining in the territory or state; or (B) who,
22 not being bona fide residents of the territory before their
23 entry into the service, have lived in the territory or state
24 for at least 10 years following their release from active
25 military service;

26 * Sec. 2. Any loans made between July 18, 1960, and the ef-
27 fective date of this Act to World War II veterans who, not being
28 bona fide residents of the territory before their entry into the
29 service, have lived in the territory or state for at least 10

1 years following their release from active military service are
2 valid loans.

3 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
4 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
