6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to gun clubs."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 5 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

9 CHAPTER 30

10 Sec. 05.30.010. GUN CLUBS. (a) A domestic corporation,  
11 club, or association formed for the purpose of sharpshooting  
12 or improving in the use of firearms may acquire suitable  
13 grounds for it, and may establish, use, and maintain a rifle,  
14 pistol, or shotgun range for its exercises.

15 (b) After the grounds and range are permanently located  
16 and improved by the crection of buildings, breastworks, ram-  
17 parts, traps, houses, and the like, no public street may be  
18 opened through the tract so used and occupied unless the  
19 necessity for opening the street is first established by the  
20 verdict of a jury. No person who, after the locating and  
21 improving of the grounds and range, acquires title to any  
22 property which may be adversely affected by exercises at the  
23 range may bring suit to restrain, enjoin, or impede the  
24 exercises.
