BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 11.15 is amended by adding a new section to  
11 read:

Sec. 11.15.134. LEWD OR LASCIVIOUS ACTS TOWARD CHIL-

DREN. (a) A person who commits a lewd or lascivious act,  
14 including an act constituting another crime, upon or with the  
15 body of a child under 16 years of age, intending to arouse,  
16 appeal to, or gratify his lust, passions, or sexual desires,  
17 or the lust, passions, or sexual desires of the child, is  
18 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 10 years nor  
19 less than one year.

20

(b) No court may suspend the sentence of a person con-  
21 victed of violating (a) of this section until the court ob-  
22 tains a report from a reputable psychiatrist stating the  
23 mental condition of the person. No paroling authority may  
24 parole a person convicted of violating (a) of this section  
25 until the paroling authority receives a report from a reput-  
26 able psychiatrist stating the mental condition of the person  
27 and stating that the person was under observation while con-  
28 fined in prison.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage

1 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
