6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to sellers and distributors  
7 of alcoholic beverages."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 04.10.180 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 04.10.180. FINANCIAL INTEREST AND PERSONAL SUPER-  
11 INTENDENCE. No person other than the licensee shall have a  
12 direct or indirect financial interest in the business for  
13 which the license is issued. The licensee may carry on the  
14 business personally or through his servants and agents, but  
15 is primarily responsible for all debts incurred and torts  
16 and crimes committed in the conduct of the business carried  
17 under his license, [IS SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LAWFUL  
18 CONDUCT OF THE BUSINESS LICENSED UNDER THIS TITLE] except as  
19 provided in this title.

20 \* Sec. 2. AS 04.10.330 is amended by adding a new subsection  
21 to read:

22 (c) A license may be attached and sold at execution.  
23 A purchaser at execution must have the same qualifications  
24 as an applicant for the license, and must be approved by the  
25 board. Unless he is the sole creditor, a person with a  
26 wholesale license may not attach a license or purchase one  
27 at an execution sale.
